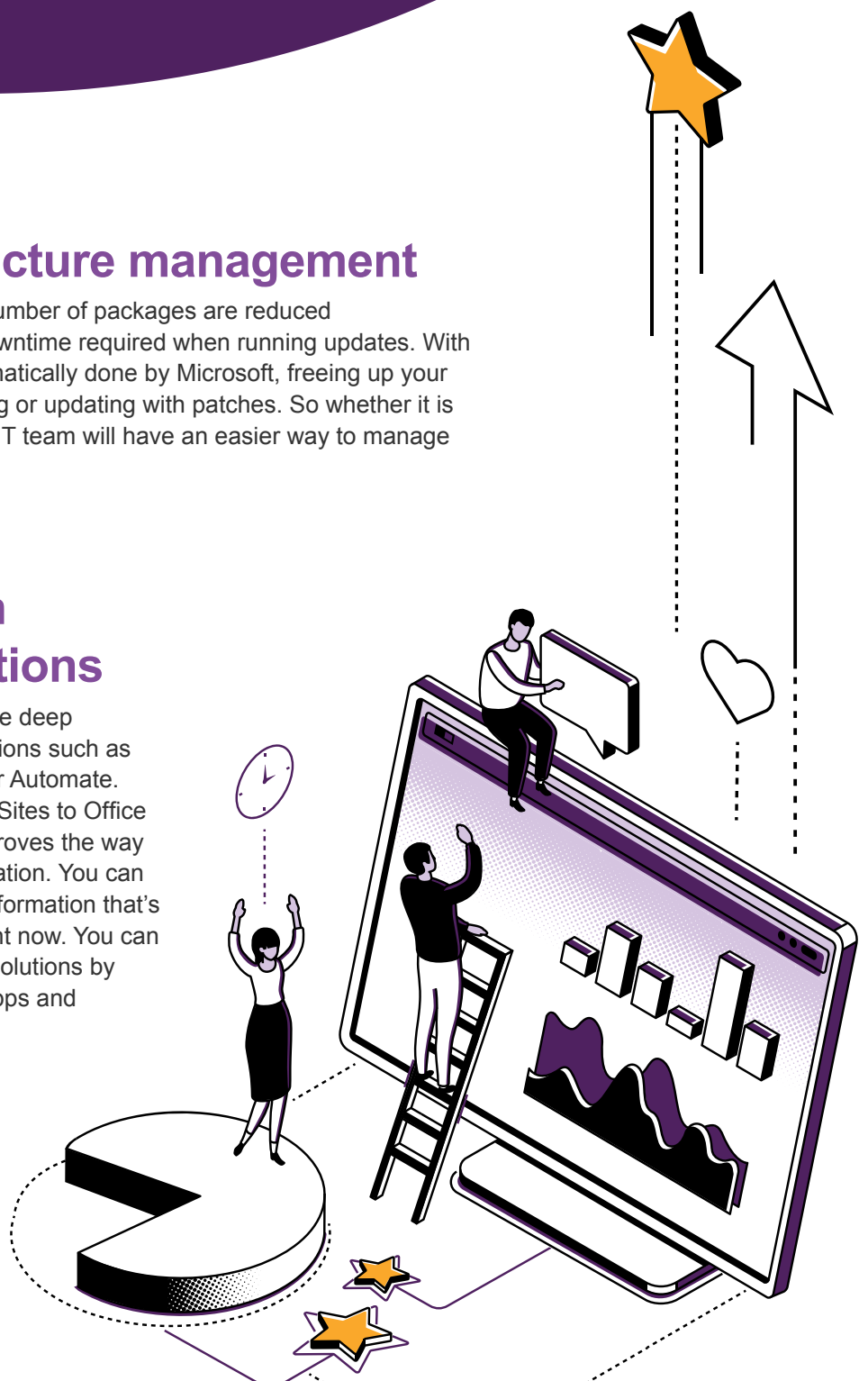

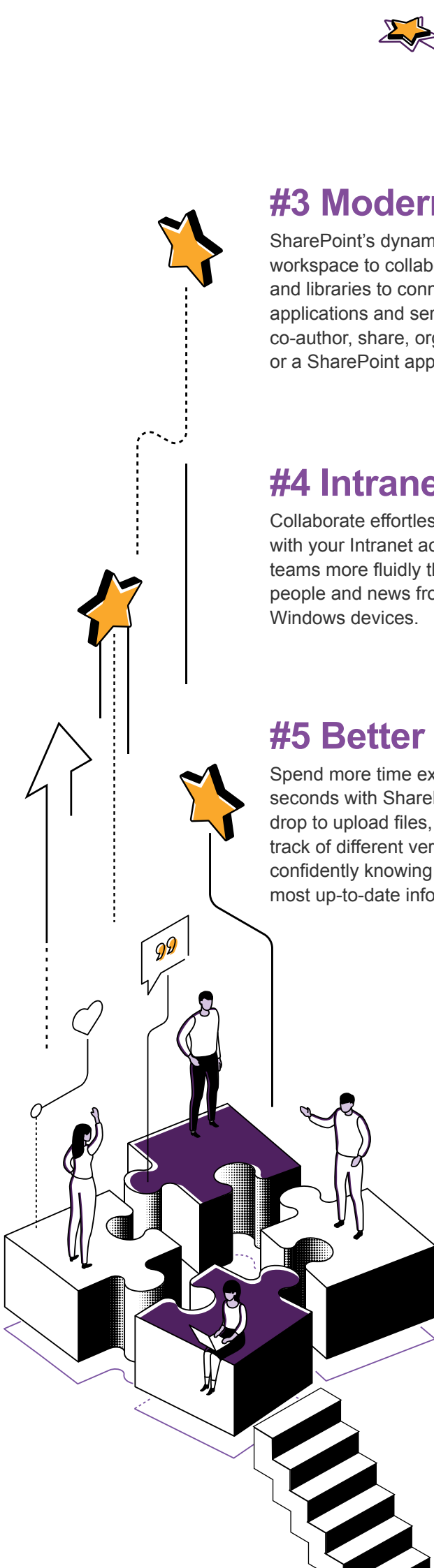
#5 Better user experience

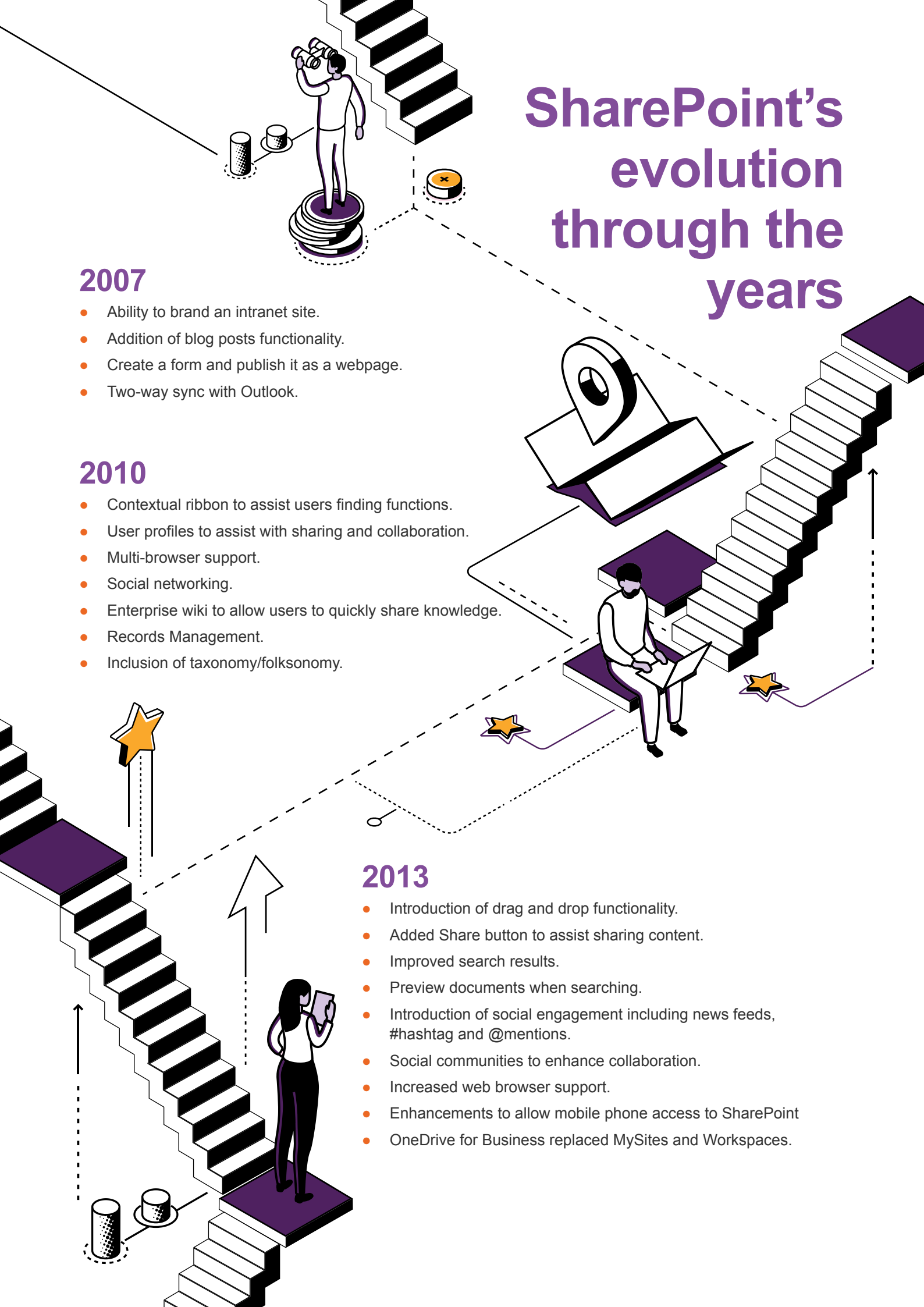
#6 Keep your data secure

If you are still on SharePoint 2010 or 2013, then your portal is extremely vulnerable to a cyber security attack. Microsoft is no longer supporting these SharePoint versions, so there are no more patches available. If you are using SharePoint 2016, its mainstream support will end soon in July 2021 unless you are on extended support.

SharePoint Online has enterprise-level security that protects your data and organisation across devices with Microsoft's thorough and effective security measures. Running on top of Microsoft Azure, one of the world's most secure and robust cloud platform, it is compliant with the strictest and most rigid international and regional data protection regulation. You can be confident that your data in your intranet is safe and secure.

2007

- Ability to brand an intranet site.
- Addition of blog posts functionality.
- Create a form and publish it as a webpage.
- Two-way sync with Outlook.

2010

- Contextual ribbon to assist users finding functions.
- User profiles to assist with sharing and collaboration.
- Multi-browser support.
- Social networking.
- Enterprise wiki to allow users to quickly share knowledge.
- Records Management.
- Inclusion of taxonomy/folksonomy.

2013

- Introduction of drag and drop functionality.
- Added Share button to assist sharing content.
- Improved search results.
- Preview documents when searching.
- Introduction of social engagement including news feeds, #hashtag and @mentions.
- Social communities to enhance collaboration.
- Increased web browser support.
- Enhancements to allow mobile phone access to SharePoint
- OneDrive for Business replaced MySites and Workspaces.



2016

- Ability to connect SharePoint to Office365 to allow users to have an integrated experience.
- Modern team sites to assist easy build pages.
- Modern list and document library experience to enhance finding documents and collaboration.
- Ability to upgrade without downtime.
- SharePoint Mobile App.

2019

- Modern team and communication sites.
- Dynamic page layouts.
- Modern search experience. See search results as you type in keywords. Unify search across all sites – on-premise or in the cloud.
- Better user experience with user-friendly pages, web parts and authoring.
- Sync files with the new OneDrive sync client.
- Improved support for business process automation technologies such as Power Apps and Power Automate.
- Modern integration to IIS.
- SMTP authentication for sending emails.
- Improved PowerShell commandlets.
- Increased file size limit to 15 GB for an individual file upload to SharePoint.
- 400-character path limit.
- Site provisioning takes only a few minutes to create with existing templates.

- New features enabled here first.
- File size limit of 15 GB for an individual file upload to SharePoint.
