All sales made in Dynamics GP are integrated to Dynamics RMS, allowing for consolidated sales reporting, helping improve the quality of your decisions.

Improve inventory management

Real time transaction level integration that is easy to monitor and simple to reconcile allows you to better manage your stock, with full visibility of stock locations from either system.

Maximum results, minimum effort

No user monitoring or processing is required for the integration of any error free transaction. Users can be notified automatically if a document fails so only minimal intervention is required.

System wide inventory valuation

Integration between Dynamics RMS and Dynamics GP allows inventory to be valued company wide rather than per store.

Familiar Status Flags to identify and filter the status of an integrated document.

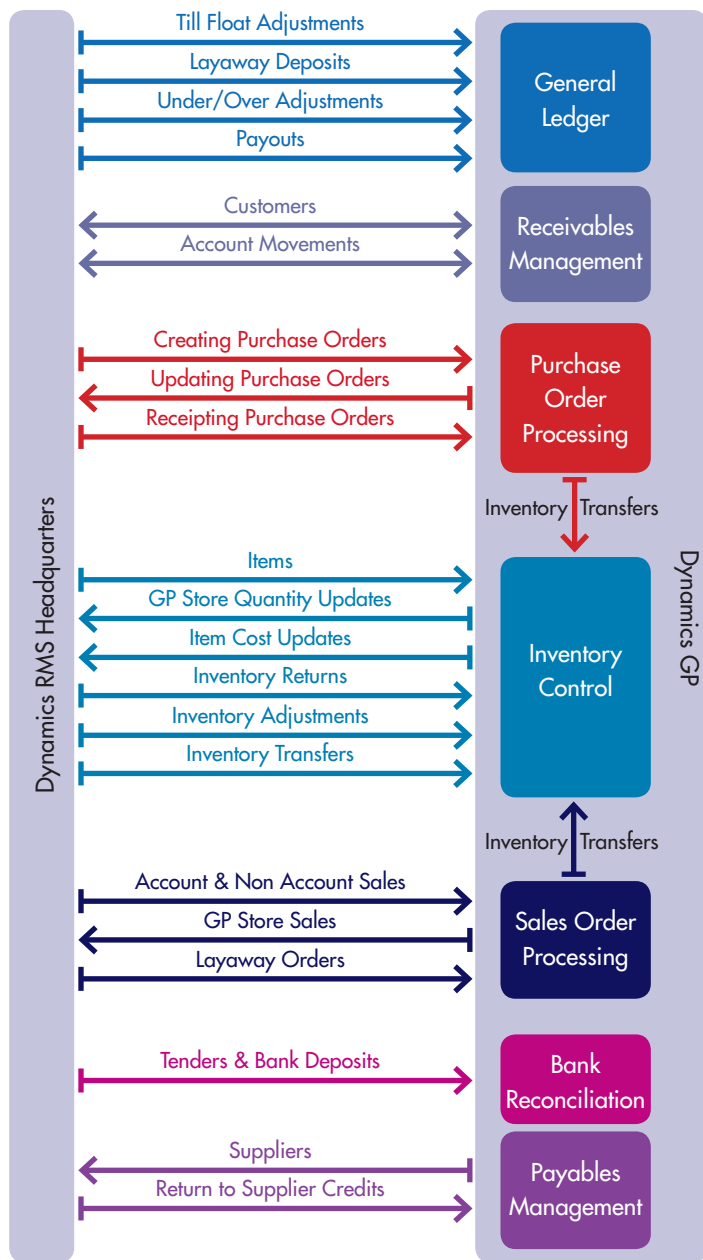
There are hundreds of features in both Dynamics GP and Dynamics RMS and not all of them are supported by RMS ConnectPro.

It is strongly recommended that a detailed review of the specific features required in both Dynamics GP and Dynamics RMS be done before implementation.



Integration Diagram

The diagram below gives an overview of integration points between the two systems and the details where the transaction can originate.



Integration Points

Some integration points are bi-directional and others are one-way. The design of the integration points also supports a centralized purchasing and/or warehousing model.

Choose the right tool for the right job

Retailing businesses have diverse requirements. For example, retailers that have central warehouse distribution centers, wholesale businesses, telephone/mail order centers or online retail websites can use Dynamics GP to meet their needs for comprehensive order fulfilment and stock control. The traditional POS retail stores can use Dynamics RMS. RMS ConnectPro gives you the power to choose.

- ❑ Dynamics RMS 2.0 with SP3 or above
- ❑ Dynamics GP 10.0 with SP4 or above
- ❑ Dynamics GP eConnect runtime
- ❑ SQL Server 2005 or 2008
- ❑ The Dynamics GP and Dynamics RMS Headquarters databases must be installed on the same SQL server



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
